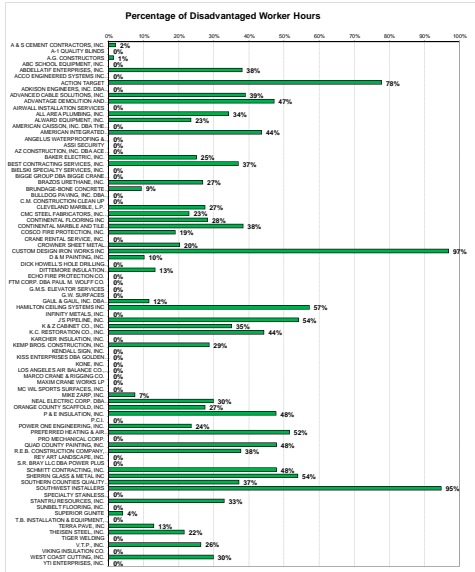

 (a) Having a household income of less than 50% of the Area Median Income (AMI), or
 (b) Being at least one of the following barriers to employment: being homeless, receiving public assistance, lacking a GED or high school diploma, having a history of involvement with the justice system, being a single parent, or suffering from chronic unemployment or underemployment.
